24th Annual Eastern Carolina Unnatural Resources Fair Supplemental Information

Dear Students and Residents,

The Unnatural Resources Institute with the help of residents, volunteers and sponsors is celebrating recycling with the 24th Unnatural Resources Fair on February 5-7, 2016 with setup on February 4th from 2:00 pm - 7:00 pm.

We ask participant to:

1. Create projects with 80% reused/recycled materials in order to qualify.
2. Identify a person or persons responsible for bringing and picking up participants' projects from the Greenville Convention Center.
3. Submit only one entry per person/group per category for this fair. *Entry forms are due by January 28, 2016.* This is so the Unnatural Resources Institute can calculate space for fair entries, due to limited number of tables. After the 28th, entries will be accepted on space available basis. Please call 252-355-1039 if you have any questions.
4. Bring entries to the convention center on the setup date, February 4th between 2:00 pm to 7:00 pm.
5. If project is larger than a refrigerator contact Jacqueline Ponder at 252-355-1039 for consideration. This requirement is due to space limitations. If entries require electricity, they should be battery operated to demonstrate.

More Fair Information:

1. Entries will be judged on Thought, Expression, Creativity, Presentation, and Usefulness/Purpose. Trophies and ribbons will be given in all categories and group combinations. Judging will be finished by 2:00 pm on February 7th. See Website www.unnaturalresources.org for description of categories.
2. All entries must be picked up from 4:00 pm to 6:00 pm on Sunday, February 7th.
3. Entry forms will be available November 1, 2015 at Pitt County Community Schools and Recreation Center, 4561 County Home Rd, Greenville, NC 27858 phone: 252-902-1975 or Visit the Unnatural Resources Institute website at www.unnaturalresources.org for more information on project ideas and a downloadable entry form. *If you are a teacher or group leader and will be submitting multiple entries, Please contact George Ponder at 252-355-1039 for special instructions.*
