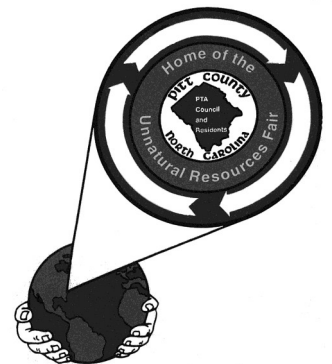

28th Annual Eastern Carolina Unnatural Resources Fair Supplemental Information

Dear Students and Residents,

The Unnatural Resources Institute with the help of residents, volunteers and sponsors is celebrating recycling with the 28th Unnatural Resources Fair on February 7-9, 2020 with setup on February 6st from 2:00 pm - 7:00 pm.

We ask participant to:

1. Create projects with 80% reused/recycled materials in order to qualify. Remember the entry can be started and completed anytime.
2. Identify a person or persons responsible for bringing and picking up participants' projects from the Greenville Convention Center.
3. Submit only one entry per person/group per category for this fair. *Entry forms are requested by January 31, 2020.* This is so the Unnatural Resources Institute can calculate space for fair entries, due to limited number of tables. After the 31st, entries will be accepted on space available basis. Please call 252-355-1039 if you have any questions.
4. Bring entries to the convention center on the setup date, February 6th between 2:00 pm to 7:00 pm.
5. If project is larger than a refrigerator contact Jacqueline Ponder at 252-355-1039 for consideration. This requirement is due to space limitations. If entries require electricity and if possible, they should be battery operated to demonstrate except lamps.

More Fair Information:

1. Entries will be judged on Thought, Expression, Creativity, Presentation, and Usefulness/Purpose. Trophies and ribbons will be given in all categories and group combinations. Judging will be finished by 2:00 pm on February 8. See Website www.unnaturalresources.org for description of categories.
2. All entries must be picked up from 3:00 pm to 5:00 pm on Sunday, February 9th.
3. Online or downloadable Entry forms are available at the Unnatural Resources Institute website at www.unnaturalresources.org . *If you are a teacher or group leader and will be submitting multiple entries, Please contact George Ponder at 252-355-1039 for special assistance and instructions.*
4. Please be sure and let us know you are participating by January 31th. After the 31st, entries will be accepted on space available basis. Please call 252-355-1039 if you have any questions. Projects do not have to be finished until fair time. Entry forms may be faxed to George Ponder at 252-355-0414.
